Procedure for Admission of students for the B. Arch, M. Arch & Ph.D programs BMS College of Architecture

Under-graduate: B.Arch. program

- The B. Arch program has an intake of 120 per year. As per guidelines from Council of Architecture (COA), New Delhi which is the governing body for Architectural education in India,
- B. Arch aspirants need to have secured a valid score in any one of the entrance exams, viz NATA or IIT-JEE 2. Students are admitted under the following categories KEA, COMEDK and Management.
- The Karnataka Examinations Authority (KEA) releases ranks of students based on their II PUC marks or 12th standard marks with Physics, Maths & Chemistry as compulsory subjects and entrance examination scores.
- KEA then allots aspirants to the Institution based on student's preference for the college. Similarly, the Consortium of Medical, Engineering and Dental Colleges of Karnataka (COMEDK) ranks students based on their II PUC / 12th standard marks and entrance examination scores and allots them to the Institution based on their preference for the college.
- The Management candidates are selected and allotted by the BMS Management based on the merit and a valid NATA / JEE 2 score in line with the guidelines specified in COA regulations for admissions.

Post-graduate: M.Arch (Habitat Design) program

- The M. Arch. program has an intake of 20 per year.
- Students are admitted under the following categories KEA and Management.
- M. Arch aspirants need to have secured a valid score in any one of the entrance exams, viz KPGCET or GATE.
- The Karnataka Examinations Authority (KEA) releases ranks to students based on their B. Arch marks and entrance examination scores as well as applicable Category, if any and allots them to the Institution based on their preference for the college.
- If any seats are left beyond this, the College can conduct an aptitude test; further if eligible the student may be admitted to M. Arch program under Management category as per applicable norms stipulated in the Admission clauses of University.
- The same shall be communicated to the University with all documents.

Ph.D. Research Program

- The Ph.D. program aspirants at the Research Centre, BMS College of Architecture need to approach a Research Supervisor under VTU & currently a faculty at BMSCA to register their application for VTU-ETR (VTU Entrance Exam for PhD).
- Successful candidates need to follow the procedure as per the applicable VTU PhD Regulations to have their synopsis reviewed by a University level Selection Committee.
- The university issues them a provisional Admission letter formalizing the admission procedure if found eligible.
